BENEFIT for Diane De Leo

Diane De Leo is the wife of the Great Lakes Regional Umpire in Chief, Mike De Leo. Mike has served as the ASA Region 08 Umpire in Chief since 2000. In February, Diane was diagnosed with Guillian-Barre Syndrome. Guillian-Barre Syndrome is when your immune system begins attacking the nerves that carry signals between your body and your brain. Specifically the nerves protective covering is damaged and this interferes with the signaling process, causing weakness, numbness, paralysis.

In July, Diane entered a Rehab Facility in Saginaw, while there Diane had another illness in which she had her entire colon removed. After Surgery Mike was contacted by his insurance company stating they had used up all the days allowed, there for leaving them without any insurance coverage and no state help. Diane still needs several months of rehab which they now pay out of pocket. The cost is roughly \$ 6000.00 per month. Diane's recovery period may be up to two years or longer.
