POOLS OF THREE: In pools of three teams, the teams shall play each team in the pool once each. The following tie breaker will be used: (a) Record, (b) Head to head (if only two teams), (c) Fewest runs allowed, (d) Most runs scored, (e) Draw.

POOLS OF FOUR: In pools of four teams, a draw will be used to determine which other team theplay in their first game. The winners of each of the first games in a pool shall play each other with the winner being declared the Number 1 seed in the pool and the loser being declared the Number 2 seed. The losers of each of the first games in a pool shall play each other with the winner being declared the Number 3 seed in the pool and the loser being declared the Number 4 seed.
