FAQs

1. Is the insurance for one sport at a time?
Example football or basketball.

Answer: *No. The policy covers an official for all sports. However, all sports must be listed at the time of registration.*

2. Does this insurance cover NCAA, MHSAA, MIAA, MAC softball, etc.

Answer: *Yes. But does not cover Any other Non-ASA Softball.*

3. Is the accident coverage for a 26 week period or a full year?

Answer: *Accident coverage for game fees for 26 weeks!*

4. Does the league or sport the official works have to be sanctioned by ASA?

Answer: *No ASA sanction unless a softball league. It could be a church basketball league.*

5. Does coverage include travel to and from the game?

Answer: *Direct travel only!*

6. How do I register for the MASA Sports Officials Insurance Plan?

Answer: *Complete the application and remit with a check or money order to MASA in the amount of \$25 per official, or complete it online.*

7. What is the term of this policy?

Answer: *Policies renewed prior to April 1, 2012 will have an effective date of January 1, 2012. For renewals received on or after April 1, 2012, effective date will be the day after postmark on envelope.*
